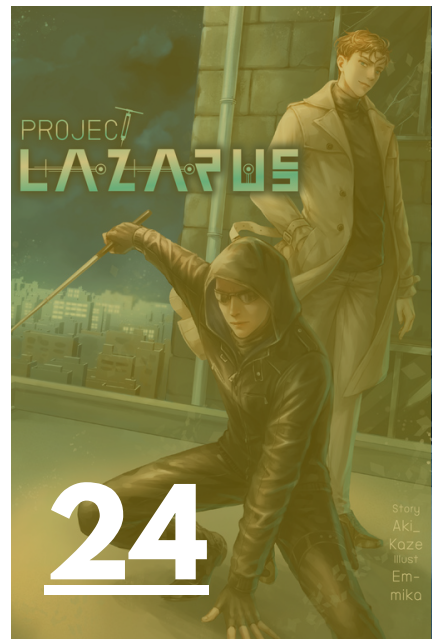

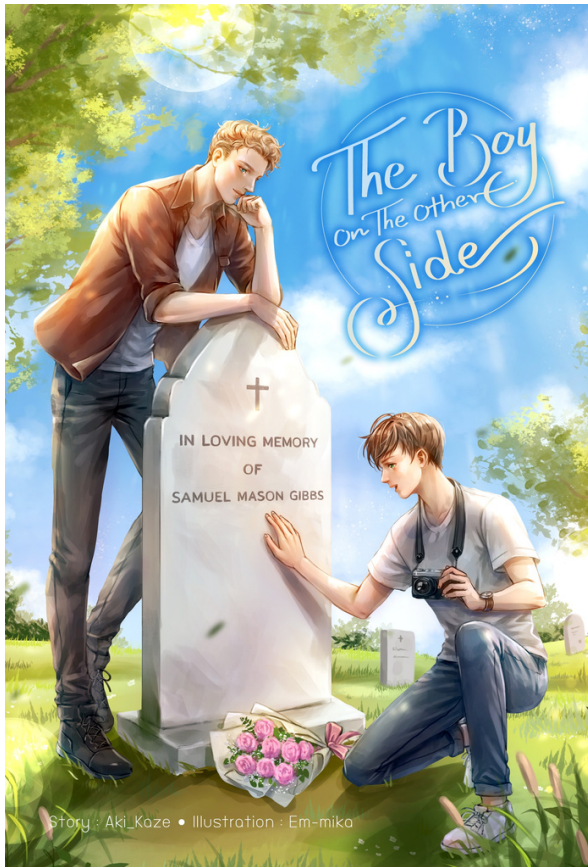

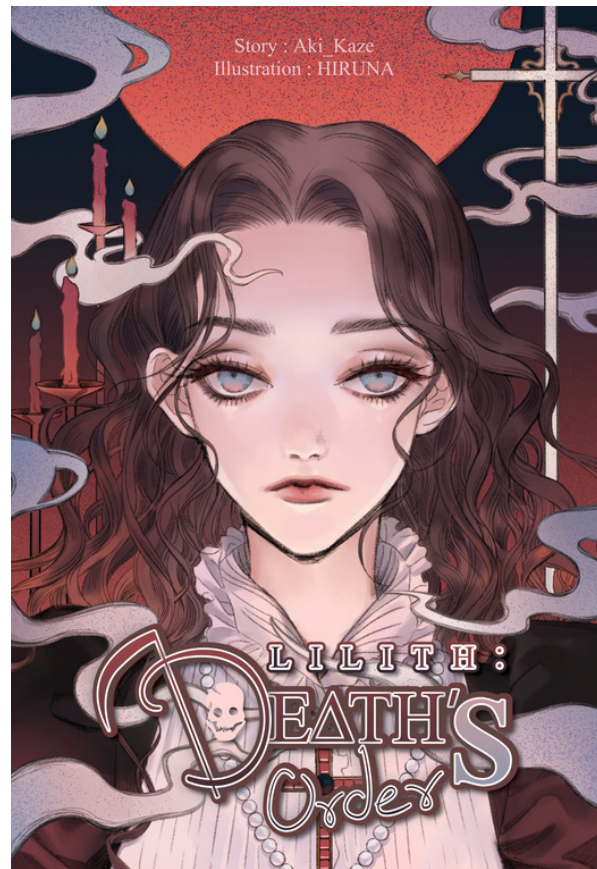

The killer was released because they cannot connect him to the Carver.

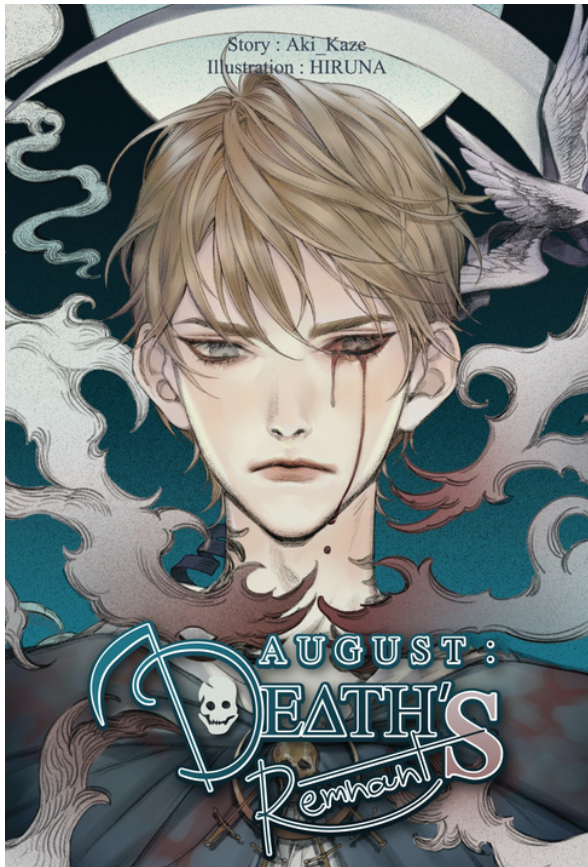
